Full-format article requirements for CEUR:

- It should be prepared using new CEUR-style template (<http://ims.ifmo.ru/file/pages/10/CEUR-Template-1col.docx>).
- It should contain 6-12 pages.
- The language of the article is English.

## SUBMISSION

- Authors need to submit a paper to **E-Governance2021** workshop via the EasyChair system (<https://easychair.org/my/conference?conf=egov20210>)
- To be accepted to the workshop a paper must be original, not published anywhere else before or being under review;
- All papers undergo a double-blind peer review;
- The authors of accepted papers will be invited to participate in the workshop as speakers.
